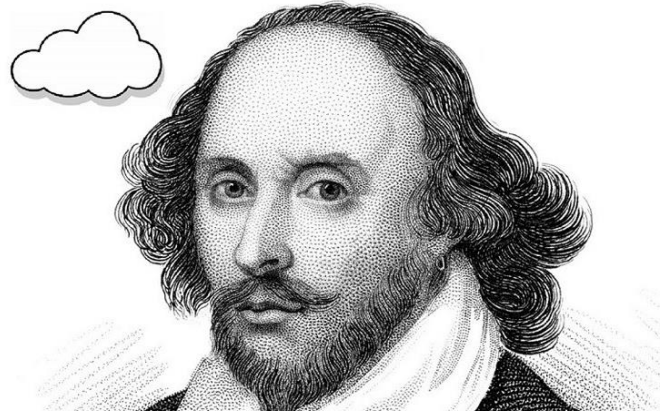


# Kegsoft Lunchtime Challenge #1 Shakespeare in the cloud



Creating quick tactical applications in a busy working environment is never easy - not only do you need to have your requirements and specifications precisely pinned down but creating a solution that can be shared or published often involves amalgamating several different technologies. The Kegsoft Business Language (KBL) is a self-contained Studio environment that works happily with familiar office files and methods - overcoming many of the frustrations experienced fulfilling business-IT tasks when up against the clock. KBL is designed to be accessible to business-focussed users as well as IT specialists. You don't need SQL, cell formulae or low-level programming methods but you will need common sense and a logical mind. To make the point, I'm going to feature some 'Lunch Time Challenges' using KBL.

Life's not all about industry and commerce so in this first 'challenge' we build a 'mini-application' to read and analyse dialogue. To keep it just a bit topical, I'll draw the text files down from the cloud and drop in the odd reference to Big Data (to be explored in other challenges).
